Bird Watching - In early spring look out for the domed nest of the magpie. The twiggy platform of the woodpigeons and collared doves in taller hedges and conifers. You might see the bulky nests of carrion crows, all alone in tall oaks. Listen to the beautiful songs, especially of the robin, blackbird and songthrush. The moorhen and coot on the pond are a delight to watch as they defend their territories and build nests. Watch out for the first migrants from Africa and Southern Europe; swallows, sand martin and chaffinch (song like name). Thoroughly clean nest boxes, repairing and replacing as necessary. Always place them in a sheltered spot, out of direct sunlight and reach of cats; but put them where you can see them to experience the pleasure they can bring.
