**Bird Watching** - Short days will mean that birds feed more intensively, bringing a greater number into your garden. Look out for coal tits, blue tits, great tits, goldfinches and greenfinches on your feeders; perhaps even siskin or great spotted woodpecker.

On the ground the foraging song thrush, blackbird and robin are delightful.

Water bird numbers, especially ducks, geese and coot build up on the pond. The tiny goldcrest can often be seen around the estate.

For Christmas, treat yourself to an identification book, a pair of binoculars or feeders, then after providing fresh food and water, enjoy endless hours of pleasure from your windows.
